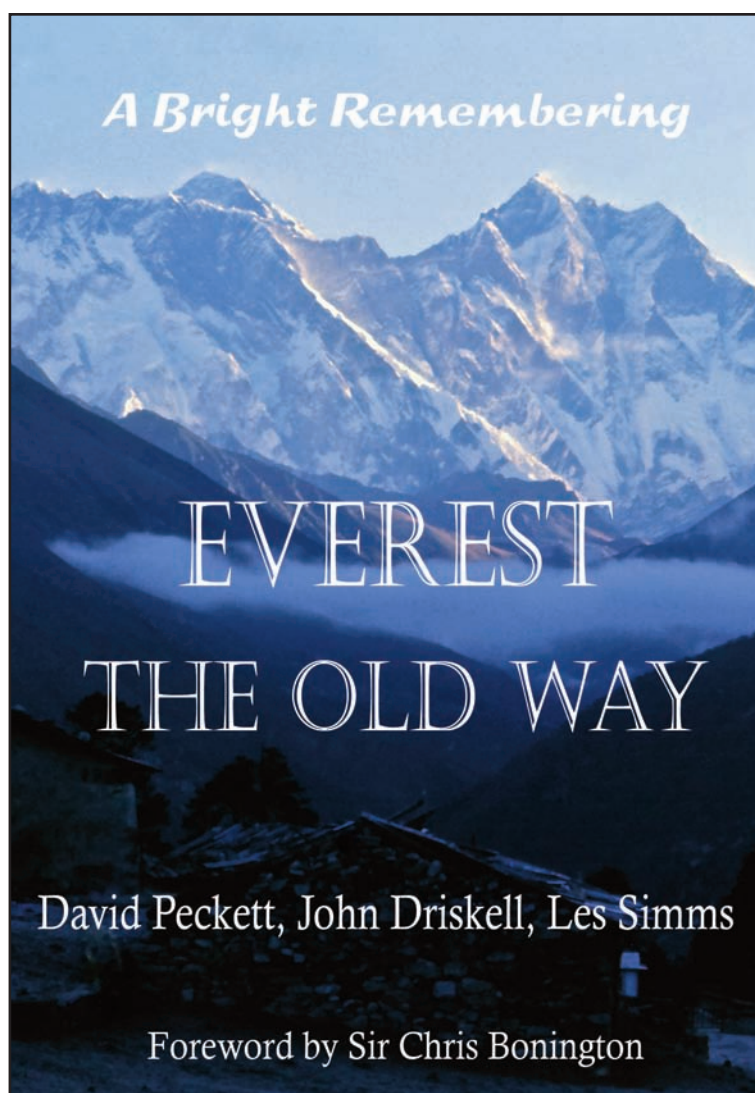
**Everest The Old Way - From Barnsley to Base Camp**

John and David take us through the story of how four men and a woman drove from Barnsley to Kathmandu and then walked to Mt. Everest.

After saving a quarter of their £40 teacher's salary for 2 years they set off in Nov 1967 reaching Everest on the 5th Mar 1968, a time when the world was a very different place. They claim this is the first recorded trek to Mt Everest

The talk also examines the inspiration behind the journey and reflects on the changes over time, following a return visit in 2010.
