

Craigallan – Rucksack Club Scottish Hut

Location OS Grid Reference: NN 030596

Situated on the A828 towards Oban from Ballachullish.

After the roundabout follow the road for 1.7 miles past the Ballachullish hotel and golf course.

Turn left into the Forestry Commission track signposted Leitir Mhor
Craigallan is on the right just around the bend.

Parking

Please keep the gates closed.

There is parking for approximately 8 cars inside the gates. Overspill parking is on the track outside of the gates – please leave access to the track available.

Accommodation

12 bunks in 2 rooms upstairs (pillows provided)

Overspill sleeping in the lounge downstairs for up to 6 people.

Camping is allowed when the hut is full (campers pay the normal hut fee rates)

Facilities

- Entrance hall – please see notices
- Drying room with dehumidifier on a timer.
- Dining room with log/coal burning stove (logs and coal provided). Please refer to instructions for lighting and refueling stove. **The stove has been damaged by overheating resulting in costly repairs. Please do not over-fuel or misuse the stove.**
- Kitchen – well equipped with pots, pans and utensils. 2 fridges (one with small freezer compartment), electric oven, grill and 2 electric hobs (4 rings each), microwave, kettles and toasters. (clean tea towels in bottom drawer)
- Lounge with electric fire.
- Downstairs toilet, urinals, shower and wash basins
- Upstairs toilet shower and washbasin
- Liquid soap and all cleaning equipment provided (spares under the kitchen sink). Toilet roll spares on top shelf in dining room. Dyson, brushes and mops in hallway. 'Henry' in upstairs bedroom or on landing.

Electricity

Included in the fees – please use sensibly

Supply is left on at all times

Downstairs hot water to all sinks is provided by activating the timer switch in the entrance hall near the downstairs bathroom door.

Upstairs hot water to the sink is activated with the timer switch on the fuse board near the entrance door.

Both showers heat water on demand.

Water

As a precaution, the water should be turned off at the main stop tap in between visits. The stop tap is behind the bin in the corner of the kitchen.

Water heaters are on timers – see above.

Sewage

Septic tank – please do not put anything down the toilets and drains which could cause a blockage

Rubbish and Recycling

There is no collection of rubbish!

All rubbish must be removed on departure – please see notice for information about recycling points.

Compost bins can be found in the garden. Please do not use for meat, bread, cooked food etc

Shed

Available for bike and ski storage (also houses lawn mower and strimmer if you have time to cut the grass during your stay).

Hut key opens the shed. Please keep locked.

Spare logs, kindling and coal are stored adjacent to the shed.

Restrictions

- No televisions
- No radios
- No dogs
- Please use mobile phones and other devices sensitively

On Arrival

- Please ensure all members of your party sign the visitors' book
- Read all notices
- Make sure all members of your party are familiar with the fire notices, exits, etc

On Departure

- Please put entry in log book to record details of your visit
- Fill in a payment slip noting the page and line number(s) for your group. Slips are available for cheque payments by post or payment by bank transfer.
- Complete the visitors book correctly
- PLEASE LEAVE THE HUT AS YOU WOULD WISH TO FIND IT
- **PLEASE TURN WATER OFF AT THE STOP TAP**
